Course Duration

1 day

This course is suitable for persons who have previously undergone accredited confined spaces training.

Please note this course does not include breathing apparatus [BA] training. This can be provided in our 2-day course.

Course Overview

Confined spaces refresher training is recommended at regular intervals under Australian Standards and this 1-day course is appropriate for those who have previously undergone the initial 2-day course or previous refresher training sessions. Participants will need to provide evidence of prior training before joining the course.

This course is designed to refresh participants' skills and knowledge in identifying confined space hazards and work safely in confined spaces and includes planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces; entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces and cleaning up.

Course Content

Theory

Legislation, Confined Space Entry, Risk Management, Fire Awareness, Atmospheric Testing, Ventilation Testing, Safety Equipment, Rescue.

Practical

- Calibrating and using gas detection equipment
- Use of confined space entry/ rescue equipment
- Basic confined space rescue scenarios
- Confined space work positioning techniques

In addition to the written assessment conducted, participants will also be monitored and assessed by the trainer throughout the practical session to ensure competence of each individual.

Course Outcomes

Each successful participant will receive a Statement of Attainment in RIIWH5202D Enter and Work in Confined Spaces & RIIRIS201D Conduct Local Risk Control.

Regular refresher training courses are recommended under Australian Standard AS2865-2009.
